



Test Name IsoPSA

**Methodology** Immunoassay

**Risk Threshold** IsoPSA Index > 6.0 for men 50 years or older

**Specimen Type** Lithium-heparin plasma

**Required Volume** 1.0 mL (Minimum Volume: 0.5mL)

**Collection Instructions** Only collect from male patients  $\geq$  50 years of age with an established

total PSA level of ≥ 4 ng/mL

Do not collect specimens:

• Within 72 hours after prostate manipulation, including digital rectal exam (DRE)

• Within 2 weeks after urinary tract infection and/or prostatitis

• Within 30 days after prostate surgery including prostate biopsy; urinary catheterization, prostate infarction, or endoscopic evaluation

• From patients with previous urinary tract malignancy

**Collection Container** Lithium heparin plasma separator tube (PST) or standard plasma tube

**Transport Container** For shipping on freezer packs: Standard pour-off tube

For shipping on dry ice: Cryo pour-off tubes

**Transport Temperature** Frozen

For local transport (i.e. courier/same day delivery) specimens can be

refrigerated on cold packs or controlled ambient temperature

**Specimen Stability** Refrigerated: 24 hours

Frozen: 14 days

**Report Available** 3 business days after specimen arrives at Cleveland Diagnostics
